Who can manage layouts?

This permission is used to restrict which groups can use the manage-layouts interface

confluence-administrators

Select...

This area allows you to select the user group that will be able to change the layouts via the Theme Builder Manage Layout Area. Click on the Select button and then select the appropriate group from the resultant pop-up window. Click the OK button to confirm your selection.

Who can edit CSS?

This permission is used to restrict which groups can edit the custom css

confluence-administrators

Select...

This area allows you to select the user group that will be able to access and change the [custom CSS](#) area via the layouts via the Theme Builder Manage Layout Area. Click on the Select button and then select the appropriate group from the resultant pop-up window. Click the OK button to confirm your selection.

Who can edit advanced options?

This permission is used to restrict which groups can set an as yet undetermined list of restricted options

There is a set of pseudo-groups that allow for space admin style permissions

Group Name	Function
@spaceadmin-SPACEKEY	The most efficient and secure way to grant space admins global permissions is to define the spacekey whose admins should be given permission
@spaceadmin-personal	Allow space admins of personal spaces
@spaceadmin-global	Allow admins of global spaces
@spaceadmin-*	Allow all space admins
